





The Stock Market Game[™](SMG) is a national program of the Securities Industry and Financial Markets Association (SIFMA) that allows students and teachers the opportunity to invest a virtual \$100,000 in bonds, mutual funds, and stocks in a 10-week simulation.

The program is available to all grade levels but is more easily utilized in grades 4-12 and college classes. Teams participating in the Arkansas Stock Market Game are divided into Economics Arkansas' six university based regions and three divisions (elementary- 4th- 6th grade, junior high-7th- 9th grade, and senior high- 10th- 12th grade) within each region. There is also a teacher division. The college and teacher divisions are statewide.
