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
Carousel Brainstorming

Description

What better way to review or assess students learning that to have up, moving and engaged!

Materials

- Chart paper (one sheet for each group of 4-5 students
- Markers (a different color for each group of 4-5 students)



Teacher Preparation

Prepare topics on chart paper.

Procedure

- 1. Divide students into groups of four or five. Distribute a marker to each group; pick a different marker for each group)
- 2. Explain the activity:
 - Have each group stand in front of one of the pieces of chart paper. Allow 2 minutes to respond to the statement/prompt. When time is called, all teams rotate clockwise to the next chart paper.
- 3. If a team agrees with the statement that was written before, they may place a dot beside the statement(s). If they wish to add new thoughts, simply record them below.
- 4. Repeat until all groups have been to all charts.
- 5. Ask the groups return to the chart where they began. Challenge them to summarize the statements to share with the entire group as a debriefing opportunity.
