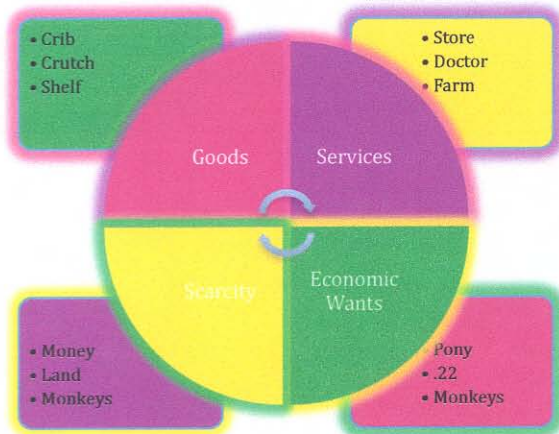

## Interdependence

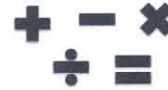
*Depending on others for the goods and services we want.*
